The schedule for the event is Family and Friend Placements (Specific Graves) from 7:30 AM until 9:00 AM.

Mass Placement begins at 9AM.

Please **RESPECT FAMILY PLACEMENT TIME** and wait until 9 or you may deprive a family of the satisfaction of placing a wreath themselves.

At 9AM Taps will play to ANNOUNCE MASS PLACEMENT

We will have 4 locations for wreath Pick-up (see attached map for onsite pickup). We will have an offsite pick-up location at Gulf Beach Highway and Navy Boulevard

across from CVS in the empty lot. Look for Kiwanis and WAA signs. It will be open from 7:30 AM until 9 AM. If you have more than a dozen to pick up, please use the Cemetery pick-up locations.

- 1. New Side Across from Area 71 in the Grass
- 2. Historic Side Near the Front Entrance to the Historic Side
- 3. Near the Rear Gate oh Historic Section
 - a. Road is one way from JOHN TOWER TO HOVEY for Cars

This year the wreaths will be packed with 12 wreaths to a carton.

Be sure to have enough people/vehicles to move and place your wreaths.

We will have very little wreath transportation available this year on the 13th.

The wreaths arrive in the week before the event, and we stage them over the cemetery based on need.
